
- In America, psychopaths are 20-25x more likely than nonpsychopaths to be incarcerated.
- Psychopaths in America are 4-8x more likely to be more violent and are resistant to most forms of treatment.
- Approximately, 93% of adult male psychopaths are incarcerated, on parole, or probation.


#### CONCLUSIONS
