Introduction

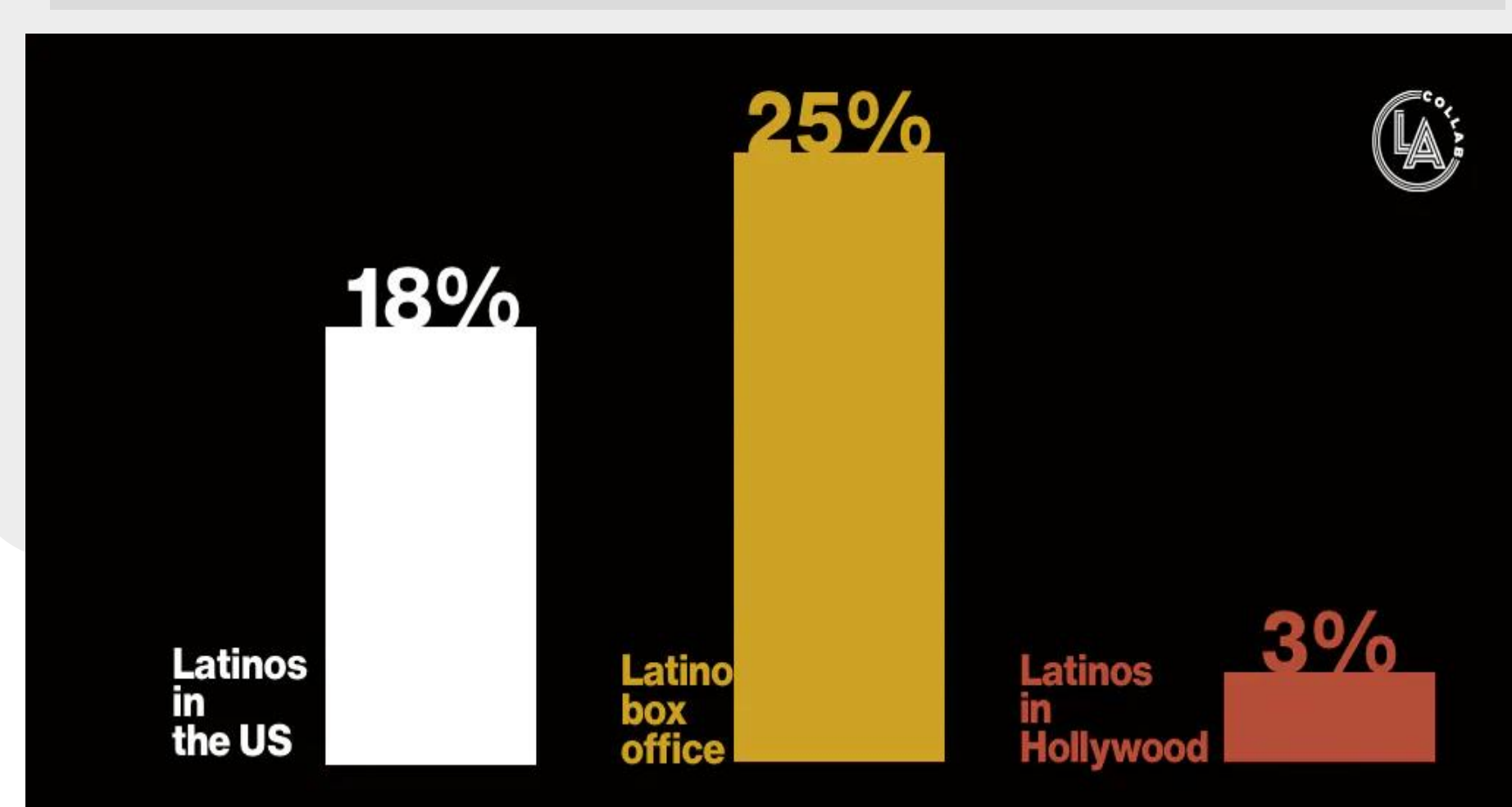

Research Question

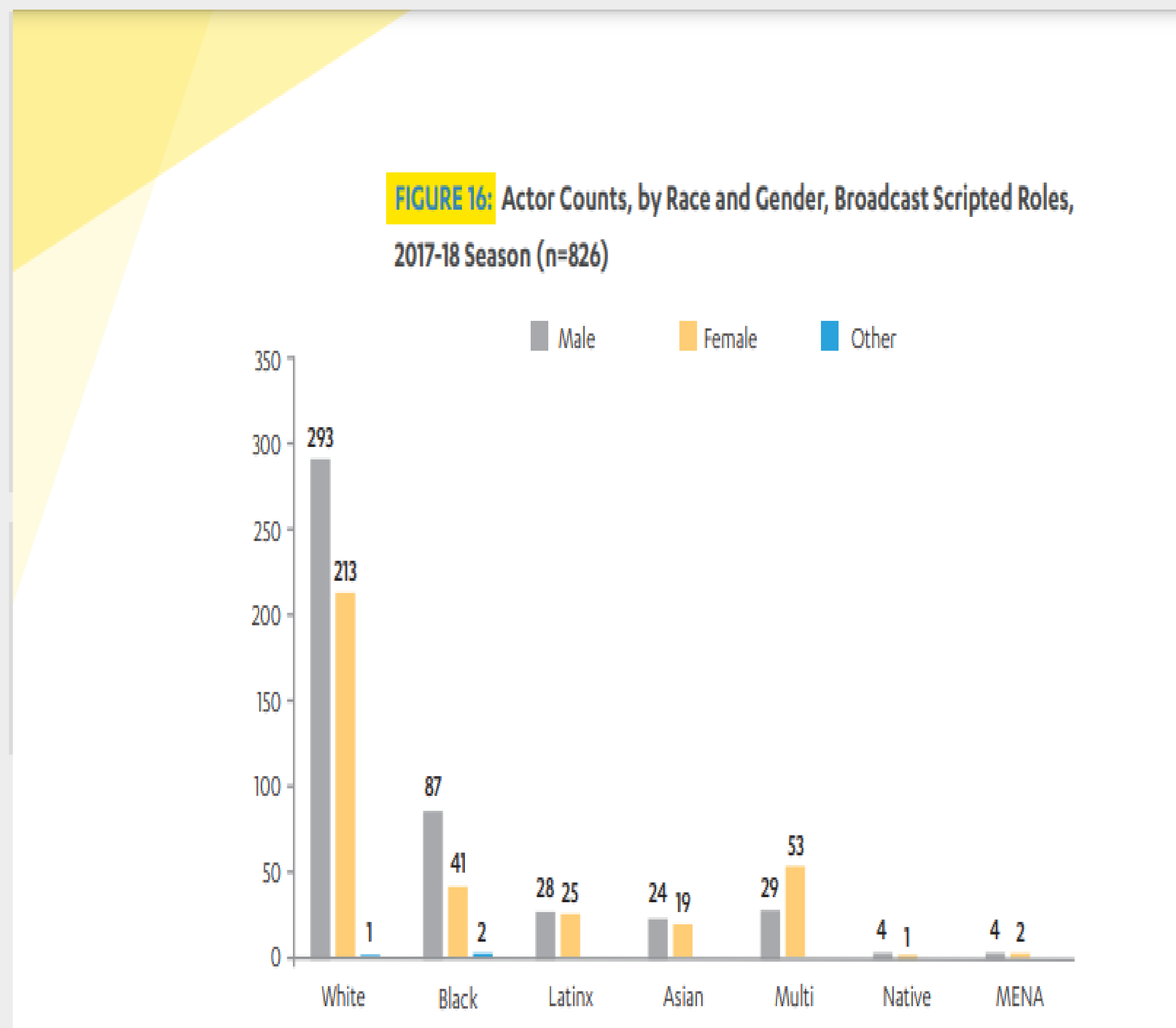
Why is there a Lack of representation of Latinos on screen and behind cameras by Hollywood entertainment and how can we fix it?
