With 2021 Lifetime Achievement Award

Dr. José Cuello is Emeritus Associate Professor of History and Latina/o Studies at Wayne State University in Detroit. He was born in Tampico, México in 1947 and became a citizen of the United States at age 14. He attended Chicago Catholic and public schools. He earned his B.A. in History from the University of Illinois in Chicago and his Ph.D. in History from the University of California in Berkeley in 1981.


